The Wine

French for "white from white," our Blanc de Blanc is composed entirely of Chardonnay grapes, the primary white grape cultivated in the Champagne region of France. Blanc de Blanc is a classic among the sparkling wines of the world, and appears at celebrations, romantic rendezvous, picnics, and dinner tables alike. Bubbly and fresh, its bright character and irrepressible effervescence make even everyday occasions special. Blanc de Blanc is a nonvintage wine, allowing our winemaker to blend juice from multiple harvest seasons to ensure a consistency in character and quality.

DID YOU KNOW?

Chardonnay is one of the most widely planted varieties in the world. Why? It's twofold. The grapes are exceptionally easy to cultivate in a multitude of climates, and the market demands it!

The Grapes

Chardonnay grown in cooler climates like that of Northern Michigan offer nuances of more highly acidic fruits like quince, starfruit and green apple. Chardonnay is one of the earlier varieties to be harvested, often coming off the vine in mid-September to early October. We harvest our Chardonnay from a variety of Michigan appellations, providing a breadth of flavor profile and balance that make this wine so irresistible.

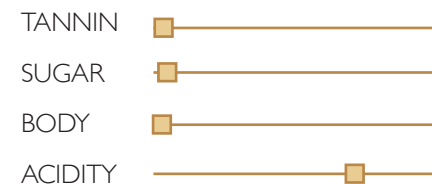
